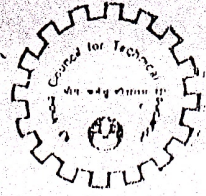

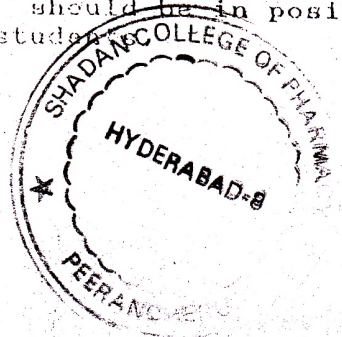
Sir,  
I am directed to state that based on the  
recommendations of the central Task Force and manpower Task  
Force, the AICTE has approved the proposal for setting of  
Shadan College of Engg. & Tech., Hyderabad to conduct the  
following courses with intake capacity shown against each  
for the academic year 1994-95 :-

S.No.	Course(s)	Level	Approved Intake
1.	Computer Sc & Engg	Degree	40 (Forty)
2.	Electronica Engg	Degree	40 (Forty)
3.	Mech. Engg.	Degree	60 (Sixty)
4.	B. Pharmacy	Degree	40 (Forty)

The above approval is subject to fulfillment of  
specific and general conditions as under:

Specific Conditions

1. The infrastructural and other facilities including  
faculty, equipment, books, etc. should be provided as  
per AICTE norms.
2. A Principal having qualifications, experience, etc. as  
per AICTE norms should be in position before admission  
of students.
3. One Professor and two lecturers in each discipline  
having qualifications, experience, etc. as per AICTE  
norms should be in position before admission of  
students.
4. The infrastructural and other facilities in terms of  
class rooms, tutorial rooms, labs, workshop, library,  
etc. as per AICTE norms for atleast First Year of the  
courses should be in position before actual admission  
of the students.



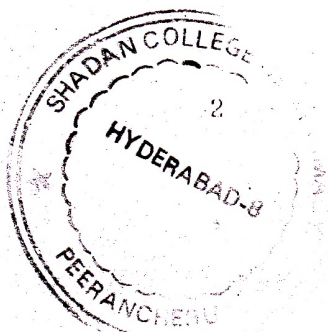

6. The infrastructural and other facilities in terms of building, labn, shops, books, etc. for subsequent years as per AICTE norms should be in position atleast six months in advance before actual start of classes of those years.
6. The teaching faculty strength should be available for each year of study well before the commencement of the course and this should be progressively raised by appointing Professors, Asstt. Professors and Lecturers as per AICTE norms maintaining the cadre proportion.
7. The Management should establish an Endowment Fund of Rs. 30 lakhs and Fixed Deposit Receipts should be mortgaged with the Director of Technical Education, Andhra Pradesh. An amount of Rs. 10 lakhs should be deposited before actual admission of students. The remaining Rs. 20.00 lakhs should be deposited by way of installments over a period of 4-years from the date of this approval.
8. The approval is subject to the condition that the Management should produce immediately (i) a duly registered undertaking on a non-judicial stamp paper and (ii) an evidence of financial soundness to the AICTE, Delhi.
9. The AICTE scales of pay should be granted to the teaching faculty.

#### General Condition

1. The Management including the Governing Body of the College shall be constituted, and its Chairman shall be appointed as per the guidelines of AICTE.
2. No new courses shall be started or an ongoing course shall be discontinued by the Institution without the prior approval of the AICTE.
3. The intake in any of the approved courses shall not be altered by the institution without the prior approval of the AICTE.
4. Adequate funds shall be available with the Institution to meet the financial obligations of recurring and non-recurring nature as prescribed by the AICTE, including Endowment Fund, as prescribed by the AICTE.
5. All infrastructural, instructional and other facilities shall be provided as per the AICTE norms prescribed from time to time.

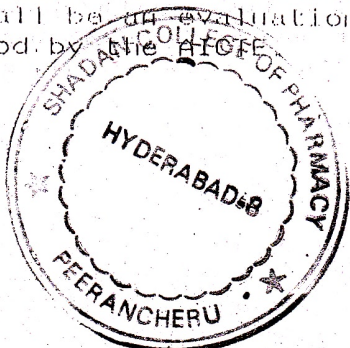

- 6. Teaching and other staff shall be selected according to the procedure, qualifications, experience and pay scales as prescribed by AICTE from time to time, and that they shall be paid full salaries and allowances regularly and in time.
- 7. The tuition and other fees shall be charged as prescribed by the State Government within the overall criteria/limits prescribed by the AICTE from time to time.
- 8. The institution shall not charge any Capitation Fee or donation for admission or other higher charges from the students/guardians of the students in any form.
- 9. Admissions shall be made on merits and as per the norms and guidelines of the AICTE.
- 10. The State Government policies for admissions of SC/ST, other weaker sections of Society etc., shall be followed by the Institution.
- 11. Institution by virtue of the approval by AICTE shall not automatically become eligible to receive financial grants or assistance from the Central or State Governments.
- 12. Institution shall maintain records and books of accounts as prescribed by the Competent Authority.
- 13. The accounts of the institution shall be audited by Chartered Accountant or any agency authorised by the Competent Authority and shall be open for inspection by the AICTE or any body authorised by it.
- 14. The Institution shall be subject to a Special Audit and inspection as prescribed by the AICTE.
- 15. Institution shall furnish requisite returns as prescribed by Competent Authority/AICTE for ensuring maintenance of standards.
- 16. The Institution may be visited by an officer or a Committee of the AICTE or of its Regional Office from time to time to review the progress made by the Institution in fulfilling the conditions as laid down by the AICTE.
- 17. The Institution shall constitute a Planning and Monitoring Board (PMB) for the continuous monitoring of implementation of norms and standards of the AICTE. There shall be an evaluation of the Institution in a plan period by the AICTE.

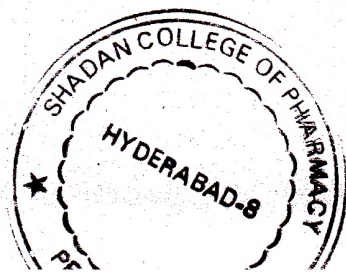

General Conditions

1. No new course(s) shall be started or an ongoing course(s) shall be discontinued without the prior approval of the AICTE.
2. The intake capacity in any of the approved course(s) shall not be increased or varied without the prior approval of the AICTE.
3. Adequate funds shall be available with the Institution to meet the financial obligations of recurring and non-recurring nature as prescribed by the AICTE, from time to time.
4. All infrastructural, instructional and other facilities shall be provided as per the AICTE norms prescribed from time to time.
5. Teaching and other staff shall be selected according to the procedure, qualifications, experience and pay scales as prescribed by AICTE from time to time, and that they shall be paid full salaries and allowances regularly and in time.
6. The tuition and other fees shall be charged as prescribed by the State Government within the overall criteria/limits as may be laid down by the AICTE from time to time.
7. Admissions shall be made according to the regulations and directions of the AICTE for such admissions in the respective technical institution or university.
8. The State Government policies for admissions of SC/ST, other weaker sections of Society etc. shall be followed by the Institution.
9. Institution by virtue of the approval by AICTE shall not automatically become eligible to receive financial grants or assistance from the Central or State Governments.
10. Institution shall maintain records and books of accounts as prescribed by the Competent Authority.
11. The Accounts of the Institution shall be audited by Chartered Accountant or any agency authorised by the Competent Authority and shall be open for inspection by the AICTE or any body authorised by it.
12. The Institution shall be subject to a Special Audit and inspection as prescribed by the AICTE.
13. Institution shall furnish requisite returns as prescribed by Competent Authority/AICTE for ensuring maintenance of standards.
14. The Institution may be visited by an officer or a Committee of the AICTE or of its Regional Office from time to time to review the progress made by the Institution in fulfilling the conditions as laid down by the AICTE.

Additional Conditions for Pvt. and Grant-in-Aid technical institutions :

15. The Governing Body of the institution shall be constituted, and its Chairman shall be appointed as per the guidelines of AICTE.
16. The institution shall not charge any Capitation Fee or donation for admission or other higher charges from the students/guardians of the students in any form.
17. The Institution shall constitute a Planning and Monitoring Board (PMB) for the continuous monitoring of implementation of norms and standards of the AICTE. There shall be an evaluation of the Institution in a plan period by the AICTE.
18. The institution should create an Endowment fund jointly in the name of the institution and the concerned State Authority to the tune of 30% of the projected peak annual recurring expenditure or as prescribed by the State Govt./UJ or Rs. 10 lakhs, whichever is more.
